[5.3.3] Women's access schemes

## Description :

Universitas Indonesia provides women's access schemes in education, scholarship, and student's communities. In 2019, the number of female students starting a degree exceeded it is of male students ( $59.85 \%$ female students vs. 40.15 percent male students). This proportion of female and male students are held across faculties, with several faculties such as the Faculty of Public Health have predominantly female students. Female students have also taken a significant role in student's communities for example Mapala UI clubs (outdoor activities). UI also supports women in gaining scholarships.

From the beginning of its academic process, UI has applied the same opportunities for male and females to be accepted as UI's students. So, there are no gender inequalities in studying at UI. The total number of female at the University of Indonesia registrants and accepted are higher than male. The difference between female and male participants who were accepted over a 4 -year period was almost the same which illustrates that women have the same opportunities as male participants to continue their education at Universitas Indonesia.
