#### **Description:**

UI Zero Plastic is a program to get students and people in UI used to not using disposable plastics. The program started with a seminar on the danger of plastic usage and the utilization of plastic alternatives. In collaboration with UPT K3L UI, Badan Eksekutif Mahasiswa (Student Executive Board) UI's Environmental Department and students organized a roadshow at UI's Vocational Programme and the Faculty of Public Health. UI Zero Plastic includes activities such as educating college students and cafeteria workers, playing some games, and exchanging plastics for tumblers. The roadshow at the Vocational Programme was held on February 26, 2019, with 50 participants, and the roadshow at the Faculty of Public Health was held on March 21, 2019, with 70 participants.
