








### **FKUI Students Holds Social Service in Banten**







#### **Description:**

University's sustainability report is published annually (2018 and 2019). The report consists of all efforts by the university in order to achieve all SDGs. This section presents the report of the tenth point of the SDGs, Reduced Inequalities, as part of the annual university's sustainability report.

This section also provides some evidence of the university's action to achieve SDG 10. UI economist Fithra Faisal advises the government regarding the issue of social disparity. Fithra noted that the government policy in the last five years actually has the potential to decrease the disparity among social classes in Indonesia. He also takes an example from the village fund policy that has budget derived from the State Budget (Anggaran Pendapatan dan Belanja Negara/APBN) that is actually increasing each year. Even though this policy has succeeded in building several infrastructures in villages, this policy is not fully effective in increasing the public's income significantly.

From the UI campus itself, Universitas Indonesia has built a new Student Activity Center building. This building consists of 8 levels which are fully dedicated to supporting the activities of UI students, as well as the university's staffs. Using the "green building" concept, this building is very environmental-friendly and disabled-friendly. This new building is hoped to encourage the students to achieve more awards as the building is also equipped with state-of-the-art facilities. The moving of the Directorate of Student Affairs and the Directorate of Alumni to this building is also expected to make the coordination process between students and the bureaucracy of the campus easier.

Another news from UI. Universitas Indonesia holds the Teaching Gender in Journalism and Media Studies workshop, as the result of the collaboration between Department of Communication Studies of Faculty of Social and Politic Science (FISIP) UI, Department of Journalism and Media Studies/Journalism, Media International Center (JMIC), Oslo Metropolitan University, Norwegia, International Association of Women in Radio and Television (IAWRT), Communication Research Center, and Institute of Social and Political Research and Development (LPPSP FISIP). This event is closed with the *Transnational Othering – Global Diversities, Media Extremism and Free Expression* (Anthology, Nordicom) book launching, which is an anthology of writings from journalists and academics all around the world.

The anthology discusses complex problems that are related to one another, such as the rise of extremism and terrorism, diversity and minority rights, as well as the rights of freedom of speech in eight different countries. One of the writing is contributed by Ade Armando from Universitas Indonesia, titled "Indonesia, when civil society, government and Islamist collide." Ade's writing depicts the freedom of speech nearing the general election in 2018. This anthology is the result of the conference of journalists and academics in Global Inter Media Dialogue (GIMD) 2017 held at FISIP UI, Depok. Therefore, the need to write down every female journalist's experience in the form of social media is very important, as it is equally important to have a strong backup that will not back down, according to Elisabeth Eide, the Director of JIMC, Oslo Metropolitan University. A formation of a network between female journalists, according to her, is important to fight for their rights as well as raising empowerment.

From the Faculty of Medicine (FK) UI, as an act of service to the public, students of FKUI held a social service in form of mass treatment in Harjawana Village, Lebak, Banten. The event that was held on Friday, 21 June 2019 is a form of collaboration between the Student Executive Board (BEM) of FKUI and the BEM of FTUI. The villagers showed their enthusiasm since early morning. This was proven by the long queue of people registering themselves for the treatment. At least 91 people signed up for the free medical check-up.
